Supply List for "Creating a Felted Hat or Vessel"

Participants will choose whether to create a cloche hat or a vessel
Working with dry needle felting at first to achieve desired shape, layers and design.
Wet felting the shape and then forming over a hat block or a vase shape.

Materials from participants for hat:

2 large towels
any wool that the participant would like to use (optional)
hat block if they have one
feathers
buttons
beads to embellish the hat as finishing touch.

Materials from participants for vessel:

2 large towels
any wool that the participant would like to use (optional)
any prefelts that the participant would like to use (optional)
vase to pull the felted vessel over (former florist bouquet vases work well or any
ceramic shape that is around 10 inches or more tall and 5-8 inches wide, more or less)

Instructor will provide all foam shapes for dry felting, needles for felting, wool batts and
wool roving, some additional prefelts and or silks for extra touches.

Supply List for "Creating a Nuno Felted Shawl"

Participants will design their own shape of shawl by creating a pattern. Then the piece will
be shibori dyed using simple dyeing techniques. The silk will then be nuno felted to complete
a beautiful unique shawl.

Materials from participants:

2 large towels
sponge
bucket
scissors
2ml plastic 6 feet long and 3 feet wide

Instructor will provide all silk, wool, dyes, tools for shibori, soap, bubble wrap 6 feet long
and 3 feet wide, plastic bath scrubby, etc. for nuno felting process.
