Supply List for "Self Portraits"



Teacher will provide

I will be providing a kit with some specialty materials. I will also be bringing my personal stash of specialty fabrics, rattail, and fibers to create hair for your portrait.

You need to bring to class:

- Sewing machine (well-oiled, lint free, with a new #12 Topstitch needle)
- General sewing supplies (small scissors, seam ripper, extra needles in a variety of sizes, pins, etc)
- Instruction manual for your sewing machine
- Zig-zag and single hole place for your sewing machine.
- Darning foot and zig-zag foot.
- 1 Fat Quarter cotton or batik for background -- Solid color (no patterns)
- Thread to match background fabric.
- Thread to match facial features: lips (reds), eyebrows (browns), eyes (blues, greens, white), Hair (grey, gold, brown, black, etc.
- 1 Fat Quarter for backing (this is a good time to search your stash for "ugly" fabric" since it won't be seen.)
- Normal sewing kit (screwdriver, lint brush, oil, extra bobbins, needles, etc)
- Small & large sharp scissors
- Large seam ripper

Optional but Fun

If you have a shirt or jacket that you always wear but are now ready to cut up, bring it. Or, if you make your own clothes, bring some of that left over fabric. Think about bringing ribbons, fake flowers, buttons, beads, necklaces, earrings, and other accessories that can help define your personal "look".
