

“Introducing a Painterly Approach to Batik”

Workshop Supply List

1. Apron/old shirt
2. 2B or 3B pencil
3. Fine Black Sharpie or black waterproof felt pen.
4. Eraser
5. Pair of scissors
6. Roll of paper towels
7. Round 10-well paint palette or 6-well paint palette for mixing colours in.
8. Some yogurt cups or small cups for dyes.
9. Push pins
10. A wooden frame for a canvas (without the canvas) or stretcher bars (only if you have stretcher bars already).
11. Silk if anyone wants to batik on silk. (I will supply only cotton and paper)
12. Hairdryer
13. Disposable plastic gloves
14. Dye brushes - named watercolour brushes - for applying dye, and some sponge brushes.
15. Waxing brushes - natural bristles - one thin flat, one pointed and one wider (2") brush.
16. Different papers, including a variety of coloured tissue papers, a few sheets of rice paper or thin watercolour paper, or even some paper napkins with fruit or fun designs on them. These can be used for making encaustic style collages.
17. Newspapers.
