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"Spring Fabric Mosaic"

Workshop Supply List

Description: We will **make a 4" x 6" "spring" fabric mosaic landscape art quilt. It will involve cutting and fusing fabrics to create a background. Additional cutting and fusing of tree and leaf fabrics to create a spring woodland scene. We will then free-motion machine quilt to add texture and depth.**

SUPPLY LIST:

1. Iron and ironing surface
2. Backing fabric: muslin 4 x 6 inches
3. Fusible Interfacing (woven or Pellon) 4 x 6 inches
4. 1/4 yard of Steam-a-seam (or 1 pkg. at JoAnn Fabrics). If you cannot find steam-a-seam, **Pellon fusible web is second choice from JoAnn's.**
5. Rotary cutter, mat and straight edge ruler
6. Fabric scissors
7. Glue stick & black med. sharpie
8. Teflon sheet (optional)

FREE-MOTION QUILTING SUPPLIES

Sewing machine

Needles 90/14 topstitch

Embroidery foot (free-motion foot or darning foot)

Various machine embroidery threads (brown, black, white, gray, lt. and dark green, (Variegated threads are great)

60 wt. bobbin thread to match backing or gray. Or whatever works best in your machine.

Extension cord & thread stand (optional)

FABRICS: (bring scraps: batiks are great, variety rather than quantity) bright & dark green

Ground: Lt. and med. green, brown, tan

Trees: brown, solid black, birch, gray tree trunk fabrics

Flowers: white
