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“Impressionist Art Quilts: Autumn”

Workshop Supply List

Description: We will make a 14” x 18” “Autumn” impressionistic landscape art quilt. It will involve cutting and layering fabrics under polyester tulle netting. It will then be free-motion machine quilted to add depth and texture.

SUPPLY LIST:

1. Backing fabric (14 x 18))
2. Batting (any kind, 14 x 18) I like cotton
3. Black tulle, polyester or nylon (20 x 24) Ann will have some if you cannot find it.
4. 505 spray baste (optional)
5. Lint roller
6. Rotary matt
7. Rotary cutter with new blade
8. Fabric Scissors
9. Black medium sharpie marker
10. Lots of quilting pins
11. Iron and ironing surface (1 or 2 irons for class to share)

FREE-MOTION QUILTING SUPPLY LIST:

Sewing machine

Needles: 90/14 topstitching

Embroidery foot, darning foot or free-motion foot

Mono-filament thread – clear or smoke

Bobbin thread – 60 wt. In gray or to match your backing fabric

Various machine embroidery threads (greens, browns, tan, black, gray, white, red, orange, yellow) Variegated threads are great.

Extension cord

Thread stand (optional)

FABRICS: Scraps of fabrics. Batiks & hand dyes work the best.

Sky: 2-4 fabrics

Ground cover: 13 green/brown/ tan (5 lights, 4 medium, 4 dark)

Tree trunks: 6-8 of browns, white (birch) or black/gray can be printed fabrics

Leaves: 4 fabrics (2 bright green, 1 red, 3 yellow/orange/gold)

Your fabric pieces do not need to be any bigger than 8” x 10”.

Ann will provide a photo to work from or you can bring your own.
