**The Land We Know
Supply List**

Sewing machine and its manual- one with a drop feed is essential for machine embroidery, plus an embroidery/quilting or darning foot, whichever you have for your machine

Spare bobbins and needles - topstitch no. 90 are ideal and I will have some with me

Scissors, pins and an embroidery hoop

Pencils and notebook or sketchbook, photos/drawings

Four strips of cardboard to use as a simple viewfinder during the design process each about 8-10 inches long

Some small pieces of cotton, calico, lightweight Vilene or similar that fit your embroidery hoop

Off cuts/little pieces of any interesting materials you have such as sheers, printed fabrics, merino or silk fibers

A selection of any favorite threads you have for machine embroidery, rayon, cotton, metallic, wool/acrylic mixes 12/30/40 weights i.e. Robison-Anton, Madeira etc.

Supplied by the teacher:

I will supply the base fabric, (un-primed cotton duck painters canvas) and I will also bring some merino wool fibers and sheers

I will bring lots of different threads for your experimentation so please DO NOT spend a fortune stocking up beforehand
