You can choose to make a hanging or covered box,
as well as a folding book and some small samples.

- If you want to cover a box:
 - Any old cigar or chocolate box is good
 - thin wood or heavy cardboard
 - Not too big
 - Tracing paper or baking parchment for a pattern.
- Copies or transfers of photos, travel ephemera (maps, post cards, postage stamps, ticket stubs etc), poem/lyrics
 - Check for color fastness
- Printing blocks or rubber stamps relating to your theme
- ½ yard strong fabric:
 - cotton, linen or thin canvas
- Plain and patterned fabric scraps to go with your theme,
 - thin weight
 - no velvet or felt.
- Organza
 - Synthetic, not silk
 - ½ yard strip and scraps
 - clear or light colors
- Scraps of fabric/paper
 - plain or patterned for printing
 - old book pages work well
 - scraps of tissue paper
 - thin foil wrappers
 - postage stamps
- Hand stitching kit
- Ribbon, buttons for embellishing
- Glue stick
- Optional:
 - Sewing machine, with a free motion foot
 - Threads and needles
