**Improvisational patchwork**

- Sewing machine
- Basic rotary cutting tools
  - Cutter, mat, ruler
- Fabric scissors
- Basic sewing supplies - threads, pins, scissors, etc.
- A variety of fabrics in different colors, patterns and textures
  - cotton, corduroy, denim and shirting.
  - Include large and small prints, geometrics, textures and solids

**Kawandi**

- Neutral color thread for basting
- Fabric scissors
- Thimble
- Needle puller or rubber thimble
- Needles
  - Bohin #7 darning, #26 chenille needle or embroidery needles of your choice
- 12 weight cotton thread
  - white or ecru
- light weight fabric for backing
  - 22” x 22” piece
- Thin cotton batting (Quilter’s Dream Request) or loosely woven fabric
  - 21” x 21” (small) or 36” x 36” (large)
- Assorted scraps
  - approximately 2” square to the size of your hand
  - strips measuring 1” to 4” wide.
- To make this process interesting and engaging, please include many different sizes, colors, and textures in your scrap selection. Light weight fabrics make it process easier.
